We have recently purthe chased used 1999 Verson 2,000 ton, straight side, 4-point, transfer press, shown at right. The unit is being refurbished and we hope to take receipt this summer sometime.



CINCINNATI 20VC RETROFIT

MTI Controls Corporation has been retrofitting a couple of our older model Cincinnati/Milacron 20VC machining centers. We performed the mechanical upgrades here before sending the units out. We needed to update the machining centers' technology and incorporate a new controller. Our Roger Rasmussen (below) is helping with the setup of the first machine. The retrofits allow for faster feed rates, constant velocity, 50% reduction in cycle times, and can handle complex geometry and part programs of any size or complexity.

A few key features: T-slotted rolling bolster; 96" X 204" bed area; 96" X 204" T-slotted ram; 20" stroke; 60" shut height; 16" slide adjustment; 15-30 variable SPM; air counter balance; air clutch and brake; light curtains; and, 72" wide windows.
