MIDWAY PRODUCTS GROUP - HEAT SHIELDS

Last month we featured another project for Midway Products Group of Monroe, Michigan. That included the design and building of two 5-station transfer dies to produce a couple of different embossed, aluminum, exhaust heat shields for GM trucks. This month, we feature a couple of similar aluminum heat shields for Midway as shown above. They are also for GM trucks, but will be produced at Midway's LPII plant (Lake Park Industries of Indiana). These exhaust shields will be produced through a different process, however, using two 7-station progressive dies.

Our die leader on this project was Todd Braman. He was assisted by Jeremy Schaap and Jeff Waite. Our design leader was Brian Schmid, with help from Luke Hansen. Brady Paulson was our project manager.
