## BRADY PAULSON RETIRES AFTER 44 YEARS



Brady Paulson retired from Greenville Tool & Die on April 14, 2023 after 44 years of service. Brady began at GTD on March 15, 1979, with no knowledge of the die making process. During his career he progressed through the ranks; first as an apprentice tool & die maker earning journeyman certification from Montcalm Community College, to die leader, tryout leader, process engineer, and Chief Program Manager. He has been one of our best and an expert in the trade.

Graduating from Lakeview High School in 1978, Brady spent his school years working on the family farm and ski business. His father, Jack Paulson, raised beef cattle until Brady was in his teens and then transitioned to crop farming that included corn, beans, and wheat.
